



Field visit of ITL students at the Port of Shanghai

A MSc. Program in “International Transport and Logistics” offered in Shanghai by WMU in collaboration with SMU

- It is a specialized MSc Program in maritime transport delivered by Sweden-based World Maritime University (WMU) in collaboration with Shanghai Maritime University (SMU) since 2005;
- It is a full-time course taught in English by an world-class international faculty;
- It is delivered in Shanghai, a fast growing center of global shipping and one of the most dynamic and culturally diversified cities in the world;
- Students from China and other countries around the world live and study together to start a professional networking for the future in the heart of a future maritime center;
- This program has attracted each year about 40 students from China (about 2/3) and other countries in Europe, North America and South-East Asia (1/3);



- Seminars and field visits are organized to places, including the port of Shanghai, which is the largest port in the world.
- Applicants should have a BSc. Degree and a certificate of English test (IELTS);
- The program starts in early July and finishes by the end of August;
- The tuition fee is RMB85,000, the fees for materials is RMB6,000 and the total living costs are around RMB58,000.

Make your MSc. study on international shipping in Shanghai a more challenging, fruitful and culturally rich experience!

- Over the past years, very strong wishes have been expressed by virtually all international students at the ITL program that a Chinese language course should be offered in parallel to the MSc. program.
- Therefore, a special program has been designed for the ITL students by SMU's Center for Chinese Studies (CCS) which has offered Chinese language (Mandarin) courses for foreigners over the last 20 years.
- Such Mandarin courses will be offered in the same building where the ITL program is delivered in downtown Shanghai, and with coordinated timetables so as to facilitate the attendance of the Chinese course by the ITL students after and between their MSc. program classes in an effective and efficient way.
- The students will be in small classes mixed with other foreign students and taught by very experienced teachers.
- SMU's CCS is one of official HSK (Official Chinese Proficiency Test, www.chinesetest.cn) centers. Registration and special tutoring are offered by the end of program to those who are interested getting a HSK qualification.
- An optional 4-month (300 hours) course is also offered prior to the MSc. program for those who want to take more Chinese.

Two options

Option A. Period: July–August (13 months), same as the MSc. program;

Total teaching: 400 hours;

Expected level: to pass HSK–3 examination.

Option B. Period: March–August (17 months);

Total teaching: 700 hours; Expected level: to pass

HSK–4 (300 hours from March to July, full time).

The tuition fee is at RMB19,800 for option A and RMB26,300 for option B.
