- Two recommendation letters from professors or associate professors (in Chinese or English);
- Language certificate;
- Statement of purpose - Around 1000 words for master's degree candidates。 Topics to cover: study and work experience, academic research results, planned research proposals and personal development objectives after graduation;

Application deadline: May 20, 2017.
